Discover Hortensia Herrero's private collection in the former Valeriola Palace. More than 50 contemporary artists of international prestige.

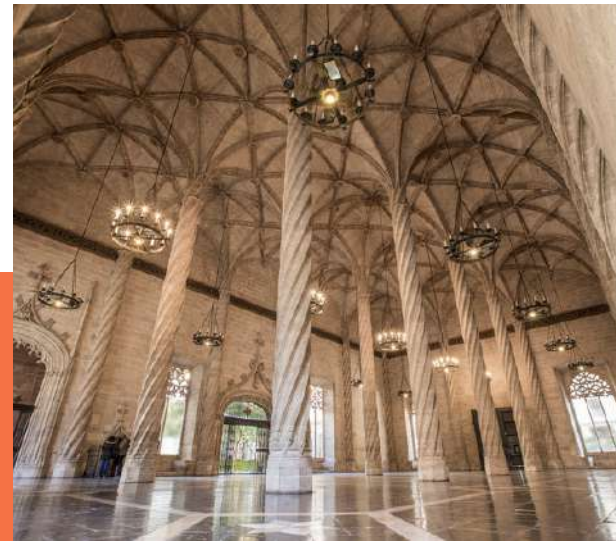
